



## CITRUS TURPENTINE (d-Limonene)

- DESCRIPTION:** d-Limonene is a naturally pure oil which is produced from citrus fruit skins—usually oranges. To obtain the oil, the citrus skins are simply pressed, and the d-Limonene is collected.
- Nature has produced this oil in living, organic plant material, and therefore, nature has methods in place to accept, reduce, breakdown, absorb and otherwise handle this oil as part of the chemistry of the Earth's living eco system. In other words, d-Limonene is BIODEGRADABLE.
- USES:** d-Limonene oil has marvellous properties as a solvent. It can be used to clean up a wide variety of other oil based substances—even if those substances were derived from petroleum sources. It easily penetrates and dissolves all of these substances: adhesives, asphalt, excrement, lipstick, scuff marks, ball point ink, make up, shoe polish, bicycle grease, soap scum, glue, mascara, stickers, bugs, tape, candle wax, grease, newspaper ink, tar, chain oil, chewing gum, tyre marks, cooking oil, hair spray, oil based paint, tree sap, crayon, hand prints, pet stains and odours, putty, lard and rubber cement.
- d-Limonene is also the ideal solvent to thin pure Tung Oil, for application to timber surfaces. Please refer to the Tung Oil data sheet for full particulars.
- SIZES:** 1 litre, 4 litre, 10 litre and 20 litre containers.
- SAFETY:** d-Limonene is classified as a medium aromatic hydrocarbon solvent with medium flashpoint. It is a **POISON** even though it is a natural product. It should be treated with the same respect given to any other solvent or turpentine product. **A full MSDS is available upon request.** d-Limonene has a flashpoint of 46 degrees C. It is classed as **flammable**. It may be irritating to the skin. It is very toxic to aquatic organisms, and should not be disposed of in waterways. Keep out of reach of children, and use in a well ventilated area. When not in use, keep in a cool dark place with the lid firmly attached. Avoid contact with the skin by wearing gloves and other protective clothing. For eye contact, flush continuously with water for 15minutes. If inhalation symptoms occur, leave the area of exposure, and seek urgent medical attention. If ingested, DO NOT induce vomiting. Wash out mouth with water and then give water to drink. Seek medical attention, and treat symptomatically. **Wash any cloths containing d-Limonene in hot soapy water, rinse, and hang to dry, as they may self combust if left unattended.**
